





Highlights:

- Mobile Audience on English Site Approaching 50%: 45% of the audience on our English-language website (uscis.gov) is now on mobile phones, up 5% since the beginning of 2018. The rise of mobile users is a trend which has continued over many years now and has yet to taper off.
- Web Traffic Down after Seasonal Surge: Not surprisingly, overall web traffic is down after the usual seasonal January surge, which follows on the usual holiday lull.







Web Traffic in Sessions*: The total sessions and users shown at the top of the "Web Traffic in Sessions" graph for all USCIS properties represents how many sessions there were to either the USCIS.gov website, E-Verify.gov (tracking for E-Verify.gov began in Sept. 2018), myUSCIS (authenticated and unauthenticated sessions counted separately) and CRIS Tools. Note that the separate sites are not simply added together to reach a correct "TOTAL" traffic number because there is overlap.



For example, in a single session, some people visit two or even all three of the domains. Additionally, on the Spanish USCIS.gov website, every session is considered a session on USCIS.gov because Spanish sessions are delineated by the /es, but they are still in the same domain as USCIS.gov.
