<p>Voluntary program* *E-Verify is required as a condition by certain state and federal laws and regulations for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Federal contracts; • Business licensing; and/or • Receipt of grants and benefits 	<p>Agency must be authorized or required by law to verify immigration Status</p>
<p>Free</p>	<p>Charges a fee based on the number and type of verification transactions</p>
<p>More than 966K enrolled employers, representing more than 3 million hiring sites</p>	<p>More than 1,190 registered agencies, representing more than 90K users</p>
<p>Helps combat document fraud</p>	<p>Helps ensure that only eligible applicants receive benefits</p>
<p>Free Self Check service for workers to confirm their own employment eligibility</p>	<p>Free CaseCheck service for benefit applicants to check the status of their SAVE case</p>
