U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) invites you to participate in a stakeholder engagement on **Wednesday, Feb. 10,** from **2 to 3 p.m. (Eastern)** to discuss the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) final rule, "Enhancing Opportunities." This is one of the recommendations published in the White House Report for <u>Modernizing & Streamlining our Legal Immigration System for the 21st Century</u>.

This final rule, <u>posted to the Federal Register</u> on Friday, Jan. 15, 2016 and effective on Tuesday, Feb. 16, 2016, revises regulations affecting highly skilled workers in the nonimmigrant classifications for specialty occupations from Chile, Singapore (H-1B1) and Australia (E-3); the immigrant classification for employment-based first preference (EB-1) outstanding professors and researchers; and nonimmigrant workers in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI)-Only Transitional Worker (CW-1) classification. The revisions to these regulations remove unnecessary hurdles that place such workers at a disadvantage when compared to similarly situated workers in other visa classifications.

USCIS will provide an overview of the regulatory revisions reflected in the final rule and respond to non-case specific questions.
